A tax rate of \$0.0195 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of Middle Pecos Groundwater Conservation District.

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2024 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Middle Pecos Groundwater Conservation District from the same properties in both the 2023 tax year and the 2024 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that Middle Pecos Groundwater Conservation District may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that Middle Pecos Groundwater Conservation District is not proposing to increase property taxes for the 2024 tax year.

The members of the governing body voted on the adoption of the proposed no new revenue tax as follows:

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, Middle Pecos Groundwater Conservation District is not required to hold an election at which voters may accept or reject the proposed tax rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the MIDDLE PECOS GCD of Middle Pecos Groundwater Conservation District at their offices or by attending the public hearing mentioned above.

The 86th Texas Legislature modified the manner in which the voter-approval tax rate is calculated to limit the rate of growth of property taxes in the state.
